

- Dr. David LeVine, Menorah Manor's Chief Medical Officer, received the Humanitarian of the Year award from the Association of Jewish Aging Services (AJAS).
- Through the generosity of an anonymous donor, Menorah Manor purchased the Biodex Balance System SD for the Lasher Family Rehabilitation Center. The Biodex helps to improve balance, increase agility, develop muscle tone and treat a wide variety of pathologies.
- Through the generosity of donors, renovations on the public areas of The Bernard L. Samson Nursing Center's 2nd and 3rd floor are beginning soon. Also, new carpet was installed at The Toby Weinman Assisted Living Residence.

Marion rallied Tampa Bay residents and provided leadership to open The Bernard L. Samson Nursing Center, the first Jewish nursing home on Florida's Gulf Coast. Her most significant accomplishments have been to help create an excellent system of care for this region's elderly, regardless of their ability to pay.

Menorah Manor is a community sponsored, charitable, not-for-profit senior healthcare organization which opened in 1985. It serves six counties on Florida's gulf coast. Menorah Manor's mission is to enhance through excellence, the quality of life, health and wellbeing of older adults and their families, consistent with Jewish values and traditions.

The Bernard L. Samson Nursing Center residents benefit from comprehensive nursing, medical and rehabilitation programs. The Lasher Family Rehabilitation Center houses therapy services including a full range of quality short and long term physical therapy, occupational therapy, and speech therapy. The newest technologies in rehabilitation are utilized.

Renew You, an intensive and therapeutic short-stay program, is designed for people recovering from surgery, an illness or an injury when hospitalization is no longer needed.

The Toby Weinman Assisted Living Residence, located on Menorah Manor's St. Petersburg campus, is the only Jewish Assisted Living Residence in southern Pinellas County. It provides its residents with an enriching lifestyle that promotes overall physical, intellectual and emotional well-being.
